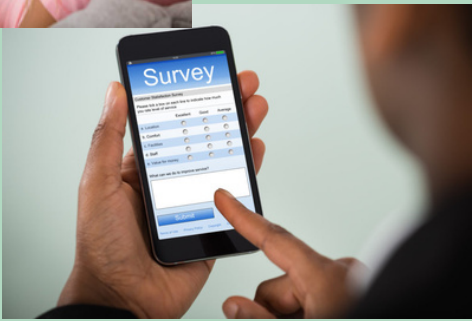


# PRESCRIBED BURN EXPERIENCE STUDY

Seeking Individuals to Participate in a Study Assessing the Experiences of Local Residents during Prescribed Burns

## AIR QUALITY MEASUREMENTS

Monitors will be placed inside and outside households to measure air quality before, during, and after a nearby prescribed burn.



## HOUSEHOLD SURVEYS

Household surveys will collect information about home characteristics and residents' experiences during a prescribed burn event. Surveys will include questions about health symptoms, perceived risks, experiences with prescribed burning and wildfire, and personal opinions.

## HEALTH MEASUREMENTS

Measurements of lung function of adult household residents before and after a nearby prescribed burn will be conducted using non-invasive spirometry techniques.
